1. Background and justification

In some areas of Cameroon, hospitals are experiencing precarious health care. This is the case of the District Medical Center (CMA) of Batchenga, in the Lékié region, located 58 km from the Cameroonian capital of Yaoundé, which suffers from a glaring lack of basic medical equipment to ensure quality care to the 6125 women and men of this place. This worrying situation affects the health and well-being of the local population.

Faced with this unpleasant situation, the YOURS **association**, which has been committed to the well-being of all since 2023, has launched the "**Help Batchenga**" project, which aims to mobilise international partners, including medical professionals and European health structures, to procure the necessary medical equipment and improve the quality of care in a sustainable way.



2. Project objectives

A. Main objective

Fill a 20-foot container with materials that can be used in the long term to sustainably improve patient care at the CMA¹ in Batchenga and to assist patients of other hospitals in the region of Lekié .

B. Specific objectives

- Establish an accurate diagnosis of the medical needs of the CMA¹ in Batchenga.
- Raise awareness among donors and international partners about the lack of equipment and the failure of the patients care system.
- Procure essential medical equipment through donations and partnerships with European hospitals and health facilities.
- Establish an efficient logistics system to transport and install the equipment at the CMA¹ in Batchenga.
- To establish partnerships that can lead to an improvement in the quality of treatment for patients in other hospitals in the coming years.

3. Method of operation

A. Diagnostic phase (January 2025) :

- Visit of the CMA¹ in Batchenga : The Yours delegation, led by its President, was received by the Director Dr. Adeline NGUAFAC.
- Collection of images and videos to illustrate the current conditions.
- Preparation of a preliminary report on the needs identified.

B. Elaboration of the project (January - February 2025) :

- Integration of the images and videos into an awareness document.
- Development of a fundraising strategy.
- Finalization of the official document to be presented to the partners.

C. Mobilization of partners (March – June 2025) :

- Search and connect with health professionals who can support the initiative at various levels.
- Solicitation of in-kind and financial donations from hospitals and European health institutions.
- Awareness campaign through various channels (media, social networks, conferences).

D. Reception and Installation of Equipment :

- Transporting the equipment received to Batchenga.
- Distribution of equipment according to the needs of the CMA¹ and the other hospitals in the region Lekié .
- Evaluating the impact of the project on the ground.
- Report to donors.
