
ACTIVITIES AND ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2024

It is important to remember that the association was officially founded on November 01, 2023. From an official point of view, the year 2024 was our first year of operation. The following activities allowed our collective to assert its social commitment in a practical way:

1. Visit to the Meinrad Hebga orphanage of PK 12 – Douala on 11/04/2024:

In this chapter, we were able to address 28 teenagers, including 04 with disabilities. The Yours collective, under the aegis of our CECM (Caravan of Civic and Moral Education), aimed to raise awareness against juvenile delinquency, to promote solidarity and other community values. Through several illustrations for the occasion, we invited teenagers to help each other and to be more attentive to their brothers and sisters with disabilities.

We played games on citizenship and morality issues and rewarded the best, shared a meal and refreshments and gave the children collected clothes (12 pants, 06 skirts, 13 T-shirts, 04 dresses, etc.).

2. Visit to the El Jireh orphanage in Douala on 06/07/2024:

After the first experience followed by many projects that could not see the light of day, this time we managed to put down our suitcases in this orphanage bringing together a total of 18 teenagers whose average age is 08 years old.

Civic and moral education was our priority, tribalism, juvenile delinquency and violence were also at the heart of our exchanges. Clothes were also given to the residents of this reception house (05 pants, 14 skirts, 13 T-shirts, 05 dresses, etc.).

3. YOURS Association advertising campaign in the cities of Douala and Yaoundé from 14/10 to 14/11/2024:

We went to the streets to meet our young compatriots with the aim of inviting them to join our ship en masse, in the hope of having a more significant impact together, strengthening our presence in the cities mentioned and conquering the neighboring rural areas. This campaign has allowed us to integrate three dozen new volunteers into our ranks and nearly 70 sympathizers.

4. General Assembly on 05/01/2025 at the premises of Global Trip Consulting (first partner) in Douala:

Supervised by the president of the collective, this meeting to present the annual report was held the day after an ordinary meeting of the board. It was a question of reporting on the new decisions taken by the administration, listening to the assessments and suggestions of volunteers, partners and sympathizers and giving the main lines of the association's annual agenda.

5. 1st Edition of the mini-festival "THE KERMESSE" on 28/12/2024 in Mbalmayo:

This important event of the year allowed us to bring together several Orphanages in the city of Mbalmayo and its surroundings: Care d'Or, Ndamboua, Family of Orphans and World Friends Korea. A total of 83 teenagers, with an average age of 11, participated.

On the podium, everyone marked us with their talents in singing, dancing, theater and others. These teenagers were entitled to free of:

- Medical consultations + malaria screening test and medicines (Arthemether, Paracetamol, Iron, etc.).
- Academic, social and professional integration counselling.
- Second-hand clothes: a total of 27 skirts and dresses, 32 pants, 45 T-shirts and shirts were offered.
- A small meal and unlimited drinks....


"The Kermesse" and its educational brilliance allowed us to offer a multidimensional panel to disadvantaged adolescents in particular and to all the youth of Mbalmayo in general. A total of 172 people from all social and professional backgrounds shared with us this moment of entertainment, education, awareness and orientation.

All this would not have been possible without the support of the organizations "Abed-Cameroun" with whom we closely organized this event and "NES-Sante" which deployed a quality medical team in the field. Not to mention the Brasseries du Cameroun (CD de Mbalmayo) and the departmental delegation of the Red Cross for Nyong-et-so'o.



CHALLENGES FACED IN 2024

Challenges encountered impact 2024- Yours association



During 2024, we mainly faced the following challenges:

- **Lack of funding:** Difficulty in obtaining grants and regular donations.
- **Lack of volunteers in rural areas:** Fewer people are involved in certain areas of the country, which slows down the development of our collective in these localities.
- **Limited access to resources:** Lack of suitable materials for the various training workshops organized.
- **Logistical constraints:** Organization of events and complicated travel.
- **Changing needs:** Constant adaptation to new public expectations.

OBJECTIVES AND PROSPECTS 2025

Aware of the limits of one-off interventions, we took the decision, at our General Assembly on January 5, 2025, to provide sustainable solutions to the needs of our beneficiaries. The following resolutions have been taken to put this new vision into practice:

*** Focus on seeking national and international partnerships** to ensure continued and effective action.

***Restructuring of the "CECM" activities Caravan of Civic and Moral Education and "Learn and Creativity"** from the first quarter of 2025, with an increased focus on public institutions, villages and districts, both rural and urban.

This approach marks a decisive step for the association, which, despite the financial challenges, is committed to professionalizing its action and strengthening its impact.

Expansion on the Cameroonian territory, the improvement of communication and visibility as well as the continuous search for volunteers and funding are still part of our 2025 strategic orientations as in previous years.

SOLIDARITY IMPACT AWARD-2024


